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Fixture Installation Instructions

- 1: This product is recommended for freshwater or saltwater aquarium.
- 2: Install the Holder onto the edge of the aquarium and secure it with the screws. The holder must be secured firmly enough to prevent the light from falling into the water.
- 3: Position the fixture over hole of "Holder" by adjusting the "Stand bar" to the proper high so that securely hold the fixture in place.
- 4: Connect the adapter to the connector on the side of light fixture.
- 5: Plug the adapter into an acceptable outlet. be sure to incorporate a "drip loop" to prevent water droplets from running down the cord and into the outlet should any water get onto the cord.
- 6: The light fixture will turn on if the switch is turned on.

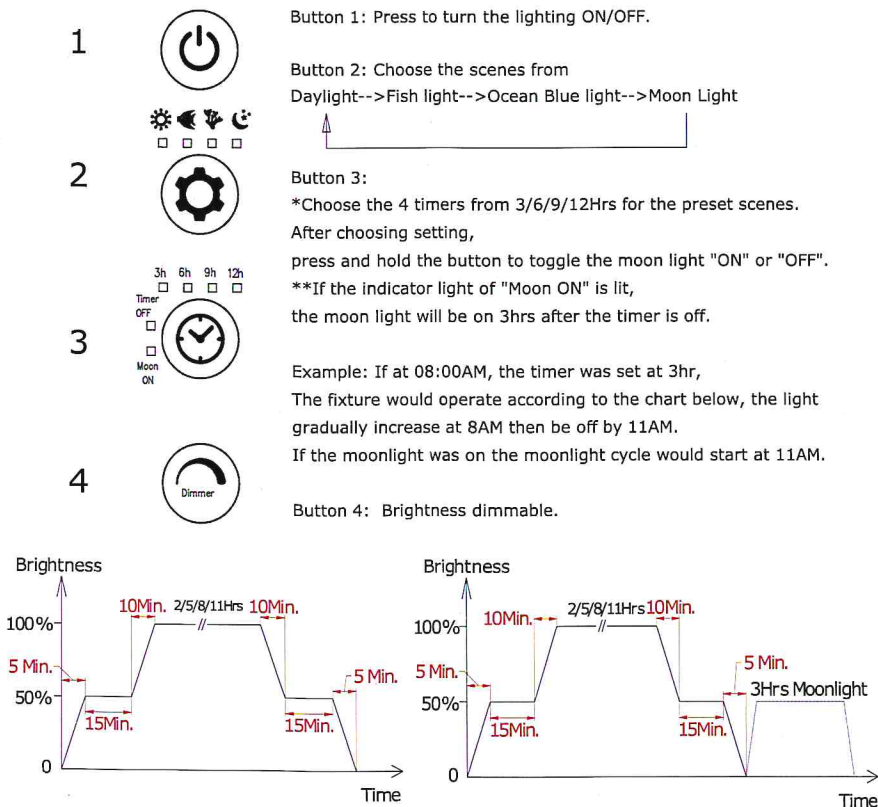

2. Instructions

Fixture installation.

- Expand both sides of metal bracket to match the length of your tank.
- Plug the adapter into an acceptable outlet, connect the adapter with the light, be sure to incorporate a "drip loop" to prevent water droplets from running down the cord and into the outlet.
